**PROPOSED AMENDMENT**

**20 CSR 2030-5.120 Scope of Examination—Land Surveyor-in-Training and Professional Land Surveyors.** The board is amending the purpose and section (2) and adding new section (3).

*PURPOSE: This rule is being amended to come into compliance with a statutory amendment via HB 2046, effective August 28, 2020.*

*PURPOSE: This rule establishes the examinations that are required of a person applying for enrollment as a land surveyor-in-training under section 327.312, RSMo, and for a person applying for licensure as a professional land surveyor **other than nonresident or resident military spouses exempt under Section 324.009(2).***

- (2) The examinations for licensure as a professional land surveyor shall be the NCEES Principles and Practice of Land Surveying and the Missouri Specific Examination covering Missouri surveying practice and Missouri statutes and rules relating to the practice of land surveying. These two (2) examinations are independent of each other and shall be graded separately. **[A] Applicants must obtain a passing score [must be obtained]** on each examination before licensure will be granted.
- (3) The examinations mandated in sections (1) and (2) of this rule shall not be required of nonresident or resident military spouses applying for licensure under section 324.009(2), RSMo.**
