PROPOSED AMENDMENT

20 CSR 2145-2.090 Name and Address Changes. The board is amending subsection (2)(A).

PURPOSE: This amendment sets a time frame for notification of a name change.

- (2) A registered geologist or geologist-registrant in-training whose name is changed by marriage or court order shall promptly—
 - (A) Notify the board of such change and provide a copy of the appropriate document indicating such change within thirty (30) days of the name change; and
