## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

20 CSR 2232-2.030 Name and Address Change, License Renewal, and Inactive License. The committee is amending section (2).

PURPOSE: This amendment adds language regarding required documentation of a change of name.

(2) A licensed interpreter whose name is legally changed shall notify the committee within thirty (30) days of the name change and provide a copy of an appropriate document sustaining the name change.
