PROPOSED AMENDMENT

20 CSR 2235-1.060 Notification of Change of Address or Name. The committee is amending the title, adding new section (2) and renumbering as necessary.

PURPOSE: This amendment adds change of name requirements.

- (1) Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the change, a licensee must inform the State Committee of Psychologists of all changes in the mailing address as it appears on the licensee's license by contacting the office of the State Committee of Psychologists.
- (2) A licensed psychologist whose name is legally changed shall notify the committee within thirty (30) days of the name change and provide a copy of an appropriate document substantiating the name change.
