Requirements**

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

20 CSR 2010-4.031 Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Documentation. The board is amending subsection (1)(E).

PURPOSE: This amendment clarifies language on CPE deficiencies.

(1) Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Records.

(E) Beginning January 1, 2021, a licensee in good standing may cure their CPE deficiencies due to a disallowance of courses or hours by the board as follows:

1. A licensee shall have thirty (30) days from the date of notice of the board's assertion of a licensee's failure to comply with the annual qualifying CPE requirements to **provide the acceptable documentation set forth in subsection (B) above, or** obtain qualifying CPE hours; and
2. Licensees requesting to use the above cure period shall submit a written application to the board on a form provided by the board no later than thirty (30) days from the date of the board's notice.
3. **To cure a deficiency, a licensee must, within thirty (30) days of the notice to cure:**
 - A. **Submit the acceptable documentation for hours denied and/or;**
 - B. **Complete new CPE courses and provide acceptable documentation.**

PUBLIC COST: This proposed amendment will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed amendment will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
