PROPOSED AMENDMENT

20 CSR 2040-2.011 Licenses. The office is amending sections (7) and (8), adding new section (9), and renumbering as necessary.

PURPOSE: This rule is being amended to increase fees for certain licensees to ensure the office has enough revenue to offset the cost of regulation. As part of these amendments the office will set a surcharge on all tickets sold or issued to each event including complimentary tickets.

(7) The following is a schedule of fees for initial licensure and renewal:

(D) Contestant—Amateur	[\$ 30.00] \$ 40.00
(H) Second	[\$ 20.00] \$ 30.00

(8) The following is a schedule of fees for federal identification cards:

(A) Initial and duplicate federal identification card	[\$15.00] \$20.00

(9) A surcharge of one dollar (\$1.00) will be charged for each ticket sold or issued to an event, including any complimentary tickets to all events regulated by the office.

~~[(9)]~~**(10)** All licenses expire on June 30 of each even numbered year following the date of issuance.

PUBLIC ENTITY COST: This proposed amendment will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed amendment will cost private entities one hundred three thousand fifty-nine dollars (\$103,059) beginning in FY23 and annually thereafter and four thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$4,250) and biennially thereafter for the life of the rule. It is anticipated that the costs will recur for the life of the rule, may vary with inflation, and are expected to increase at the rate projected by the Legislative Oversight Committee.
