Chapter 2—Licensing Requirements**

PROPOSED RESCISSION

20 CSR 2267-2.034 Issuance of Temporary Courtesy License to Nonresident Military Spouse. This rule stated the requirements and procedures for a nonresident spouse of an active-duty member of the military who was transferred to this state in the course of the member's military duty to obtain a temporary courtesy license to practice for one hundred eighty (180) days.

PURPOSE: The rule is being rescinded due to the repeal of section 324.008, RSMo.

*AUTHORITY: sections 324.008 and 324.522, RSMo 2016. * Original rule filed Sept. 13, 2019, effective March 30, 2020. Rescinded: Filed July 8, 2022.*

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
